



# Youth Safety Course Rules / Waiver Form

- All youth ages 6 and up must complete a safety course provided by SFWA Certified Instructor(s) before being permitted to accompany an adult on the firing range
- Parents or those authorized by parents or legal guardians must participate in the safety course with the youth
- Some restrictions may apply as to the type and caliber of firearm a youth who participates in the course may be permitted to shoot after successful course completion
- Youth must answer the following questions truthfully and without omission of any answers:
